Invocation: The Invocation was given by Jamie White.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor, Terry McGrath.

The minutes from the previous regular meeting were approved on a motion made by John Woods, seconded by Scott Moore. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The bills were approved to be paid out of respective funds on a motion made by Leslie Robbins, seconded by Homer Weekley. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The Mayor's Report was read by Mayor, Terry McGrath.

A motion to accept the Mayor's Report was made by Jamie White, seconded by Scott Moore. Roll call vote, all yeas.

The Villages of McConnelsville and Stockport have announced Halloween will be celebrated on October 30, 2026 from 5:30 p.m. til 7:00 p.m. A motion to have Malta date and time match was made by Jamie White and seconded by Leslie Robbins. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Morgan Local School District made a request to close Front Street from 3rd Street to Mill Street for the Morgan High School Homecoming Parade. Approved on a motion made by Leslie Robbins and seconded by Homer Weekley. Roll call vote, all yeas.

Mayor McGrath read a letter from Mike Huck resigning from his board position due to his stroke.

Bill Smith, Village Administrator:

- * Slowly getting back on track after the storms and heavy rain, dealing with water leaks
- * New meter at the Water Treatment Plant has been installed, should be electrically connected next week.
- * Submitted grant application for the river front park & boat dock expansion.
- * Next week will be taking two employees to Zanesville for training.
- * Representative from state to be here next week to do final walk-thru of the water project.
- * Water line replacement on lower part of 8th Street is upcoming.

Council President, Leslie Robbins:

- * Received a Then and Now Purchase Order. Due to questions about cost, discussion was tabled until we can verify.

Council Member, Homer Weekley:

- * "Drove around the village, it's been a tough month, but the village is looking good."

Council Member, Jamie White:

- * Asked about storm drain line – Bill reported it has not been started yet.
- * Asked about mud buildup at 12th Street and High Street – its on the schedule.

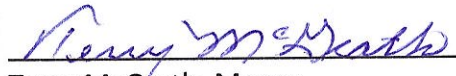
Council Member, Scott Moore:

- * Asked about a tarp or sun shield cover at Manly Park. Bill stated it is too late in the year, and the cover will be installed in the spring.
- * Letters to homeowners addressing various infractions have been mailed.

- * Update of employee handbook needs to be scheduled. Committee consisting of John Woods, Homer Weekley and Village Administrator, Bill Smith formed to review and provide suggested updates to council.
