- * Noticed that previously reported street lights out are now on

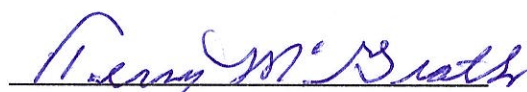
Council Member, Scott Moore:

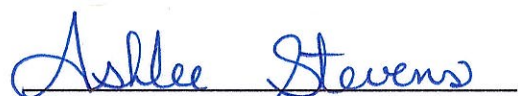
- * Working on 25-26 Report
