- * Working on a contingency plan in case we could not produce water
- * Working with businesses in case we would need bottled water in the village in case of a water shortage

- * Morgan High School robotics and electronics class want to put lights on the riverbank Wednesday before Thanksgiving

- * There are 2 cars on the upper end of Malta that need moved, 1 has no license plates, the other has expired plates from 2024, no one no longer lives where the cars are parked
- * Veterans Day Parade is November 11, 2025 lineup at 9:00 AM step off at 10:00 AM, parade starts in McConnelsville ends in Malta
- * Spectrum permit email was for high speed internet to be installed on 3rd Street
- * Township would like to know if cold patch can be put in from building to sidewalk

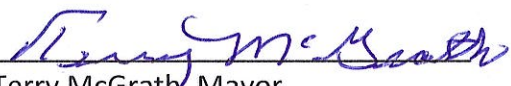
Council Member, Jamie White:
