

**A VILLAGE COUNCIL RESOLUTION TO ADOPT
A CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY FOR THE VILLAGE OF MALTA**

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest and is beneficial to the citizens of the Village of Malta to adopt and publish a Village Council Resolution setting forth a policy governing conflicts of interest; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Ethics Commission has promulgated standards for compliance by public officials in Ohio with respect to conflicts of interest; and

WHEREAS, those standards issued by the Ohio Ethics Commission are published at Chapter 102.01, et seq. and 102.03 of the Ohio Ethics Law, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 102.03 specifically addresses and governs conflicts of interest as applies to public officials and public employees; and

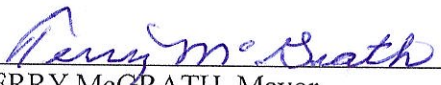
WHEREAS, it is the intention and the desire of the Village of Malta Council to adopt and codify the language of the above-referenced Ohio statutes and guidance as governing conflicts of interest for the Village of Malta public officials and employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Malta, County of Morgan, State of Ohio, that the Village of Malta hereby adopts the Ohio Ethics Law as set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 102, et seq. and attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.
